SUBJECT: Environmental Management System (EMS) Base Environmental Commitment Statement

Environmental protection is a primary management responsibility as well as the responsibility of every worker and supplier. In keeping with this statement and in accordance with AFRD 90-8 our EMS vision is to reduce waste through pollution prevention, continually improve our environmental performance by minimizing our impacts on the manmade and natural environment, and maintain compliance with all federal, state and local environmental regulations at all times. Over the years this EMS vision has led to major environmental improvements and will continue to improve and meet prioritized objectives and targets set by its cross function team and suggestions from base personnel. Our tenants include the following elements.
2. Environmental protection is a line responsibility and an important measure of worker performance. Every worker is responsible for environmental protection in the same manner as personnel and worker safety.
