

RETIREEES

If you have a Department of Defense (DoD)-issued identification card, no action is required. However, if you have an appointment with the Force Support Squadron (FSS) to obtain an ID and do not currently possess a DoD ID, please bring proof of your appointment along with a valid state ID when arriving at the main gate. Security Forces will verify your reason for access with FSS.

Civilian Retirees

As of August 2023, DoD civilian retiree ID cards are no longer valid for access to military installations. To maintain base access, DoD civilian retirees have two options:

- Enroll in the REAL ID program through the Defense Biometric Identification System (DBIDS)
- Obtain a DBIDS card, which is valid for one year

Please note that you will need to bring your Standard Form 50, Notification of Personnel Action, to the Visitor Control Center (VCC) to complete the enrollment or card issuance process. Additionally, registering a REAL ID Act-compliant ID or obtaining a DBIDS card at a specific installation's VCC only grants access to that particular installation. DoD civilian retirees will need to register separately at each DoD installation they wish to access.
